

How Sending-Receiving Relationships Can Double a District's Resources

A recent legal decision upholds a district's authority to create sending-receiving relationships.

The Commissioner of Education and the Appellate Division have breathed new life into a decades-old statute that had previously come under attack during the Corzine administration. In a decision issued in March 2012, *Edmondsott v. Bd. of Educ. of Elmer* (424 N.J. Super. 256 (App. Div. 2012)), the Appellate Division affirmed the Commissioner's decision to uphold an agreement between the Elmer and Pittsgrove boards of education.
