On August 9, 2019, a Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals panel affirmed a California district court's order permitting a class action against Facebook for allegedly using facial-recognition technology without users' written consent or a data retention policy in violation of Illinois' Biometric Information Privacy Act ("BIPA").
