Morris County Superior Court Judge W. Hunt Dumont has ruled that the family of a woman allegedly resuscitated against her wishes may sue for wrongful prolongation of life. Mr. Barnes is the attorney for the estate.

Justice Dumont stated that his ruling was a logical extension of the 1979 ruling in *Berman v. Allan*, which recognizes the doctrine of wrongful birth. "We applaud Judge Dumont's ruling as a clear extension of *Berman*," said Barnes. "The defendants clearly violated Ms. Stica's right not to be resuscitated."
