You can easily keep track of your payment by signing up for email notifications about your tax payment, each time you use IRS Direct Pay.

• Email notification will contain the confirmation number you receive at the end of a payment transaction. . The IRS continues to remind taxpayers to watch out for email schemes. You will only receive an email from IRS Direct Pay if you've requested the service

If you have already made a payment through Direct Pay, you can use your confirmation number to access the Look Up a Payment feature. You can also modify or cancel a scheduled payment until two business days before the payment date.

You can also view your payment history by accessing your online account with the IRS.

3. Click on the dropdown arrow to select a Reason for Payment choose either Tax Return or Notice to pay the tax due on your 1040 tax return. Click on Estimated Tax for quarterly estimated payments.

4. Click on the dropdown arrow to direct where your payment should be applied. Click on 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ. There is only one choice available for Estimated Tax.

5. Click on the dropdown arrow to select the tax year. Be very careful in choosing the correct year. The year should be the same as shown on the top of your 1040 Tax Return.



6. Click Continue, Confirm you have made the correct choices and Click Continue again.



7. Fill in the Verify Your Identity screen with the information from your <u>PRIOR YEAR</u> tax return. <u>Not</u> the year for which you are making the payment. Double check to ensure everything is correct, check the box to accept the Privacy Act and Click Continue.

8. Enter your payment information. **Check the box to receive email confirmation**! This is important! Ensure ALL of your information is correct.

9. The next screen will show confirmation of your payment. **Print this confirmation or save it as a pdf file.** This is also very important!
